

MEETING OF THE SMALL EXECUTIVE. SEPTEMBER 7. 1922.

PRESENT:- Messrs. Beloff, Halpern and Madame

Mrs. Mowshowitch gave a short report on the work carried out by the ORT in Summer in aid of the Colonies and Trade Schools in the Ukraine.

Mrs. Mowshowitch also gave a financial report of the ORT Committee and stated that for the coming year the Committee must have £1000 at its disposal to carry on the work which would enable the Committee to increase the means of the Central Board.

It was decided to co-opt Messrs. Wisotsky and Istorik onto the Committee and with this purpose in view Mrs. Mowshowitch is going to visit Mr. Wisotsky on Monday.

Mr. Halpern promised to approach Mr. Istorik and also to ask Messrs. Shalit and Kaline for donations in aid of the funds.

Mr. Beloff kindly offered £50 in aid of the funds and promised to approach Messrs. Lourie and Golodetz for donations.

It was decided to start soon preparations for a Ball or any other enterprise that may help to increase the funds of the Society.
