

MINUTES of Meeting of the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE with the newly co-opted members. Held on MONDAY, January 29th, 1923., at Dr. Gavronsky's house, 7, Cambridge Terrace, Regent's Park, N.W. 1.

Mr. Bramson reported on the object of his visit to London and on the results that had been achieved. He read out a list of people whom he had approached for donations and asked the Members of the Committee to visit those whom he had had no time to see. He also thought that the Committee ought to pay attention to the increase of the number of regular subscribers.

With regard to the question of intensifying the activities of the London Committee, Mr. Bramson suggested that a Presidium consisting of 5 or 7 persons be elected, in order to increase the number of active people responsible for the work of the Committee. The suggestion to elect a Presidium was carried unanimously and the following were elected:-

Dr. Krupenia and Dr. Zarchi also thought that it was possible to enrol a certain number of members in the North of London.

Mrs. Mowshowitch suggested the organising of Drawing Room meetings, and Mr. M. Shalit promised to see that small Drawing Room meetings were arranged at Mr. Finkelstone's and Mr. Rappaport's place. He suggested inviting the following persons to Mr. Rappaport's
