Meeting of the Executive Committee held on
October 4th 1928.

Mr.Halpern was in the chair.

Mr.Poliakoff explained the aim of his visit and submitted a short scheme for the work in this country. The Committee welcomed him and mentioned their desire to give him every possible assistance that he might require.

The question of an Exhibition of articles made in the ORP schools and the products of the colonies to be held in this country was discussed and it was decided to inform the Central Board that (1) The Committee did not think that an Exhibition in this country would be successful from the point of view of propaganda and secondly ^{get it} would involve the Committee in considerable expense when held in London. They ~~therefore~~ wanted the Central Board to give them some additional information with regard to the articles to be displayed, their number and volume and the length of time the Central Board proposed to hold the Exhibition so that the Committee might estimate the total expenditure they would be involved in.

With regard to the purchase of machines on behalf of relatives, it was decided to set up a small Committee of three to go into each question of credit that may be given to a relative purchasing a machine from the ORP. It was however decided that each agreement is to be entered into on behalf of the Central Board who is responsible for the delivery of the machine in good order.
