I am instructed to give you notice that the ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING of British CRT will be held at 5.30 p.m. on THURSDAY, 19th DECEMBER, 1957 at the ROSE HERTZ HALL, WOBURN HOUSE, UPPER WOBURN PLACE, W.C.1. In accordance with the Constitution elections will take place to the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE and the COUNCIL.

As regards the Executive, The Constitution provides that each year one third of the members shall retire at the Annual General Meeting and be eligible for nomination and re-election and, in cases of equality as to seniority, lots shall be drawn. The Constitution also provides that at each Annual General Meeting members of the Executive co-opted since the last Annual General Meeting retire and are eligible for nomination and re-election.
