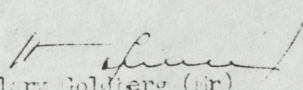
The total number of elected members of the Executive Committee may not exceed 24 members, and therefore eight (8) vacancies remain to be filled by election. There is also power to co-opt.
