Dear Member,

I am instructed to give you notice that the ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING of British O.R.T. will be held at 4.45 p.m. on WEDNESDAY, 14th DECEMBER 1960, in the Council Room of the West London Synagogue, 33 Seymour Place, Upper Berkeley St., W.1. In accordance with the Constitution elections will take place to the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE and the COUNCIL.

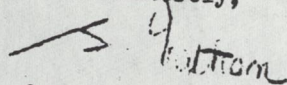
