I. The Administrative Committee take note of the report on the meeting of the Interim Committee as well as of the decision taken by the latter to allocate in principle the funds needed for the Aviation School on the basis of the submitted budget. Since the practical details have not been completely elaborated, the Administrative Committee resolve in accordance with Dr. Syngalowski's proposition, that a detailed plan should be submitted before the Aviation School is definitely realized.

II. The Administrative Committee approve of the following decisions;

a) That Mr. Shelton be delegated to Rome from his previous position with the ORT office in Milan.

b) That Mrs. Ida Mowshowitch be delegated to Italy for a few months as representative of the ORT Union and ORT director in Italy.

c) To entrust, in accordance with Dr. Lvovitch, Mr. Blass with a provisional mission in Germany in relation with the transfer of certain schools to Israel.

d) To give Mr. Jaffe paid leave until the affair in which he is concerned has been cleared up for good, as agreed with the Executive of the Italian ORT.

III. The Administrative Committee adopt the payments plan.

IV. After an exposé by Dr. Syngalowski concerning the administrative organization of the Central Office, particularly in connection with the inspectorate and the purchasing department, the administrative committee decide to invite Mr. A. Solun, director of Supply and Transport in Germany to work in the Central Office in Geneva for a trial period of 2 months.
