

MINUTES OF MEETING OF ACTIVITY COMMITTEE

The Activity Committee met at the office of Louis Boudin, 20 West 43rd Street, New York City, on April 24th, 1944, at 4:30 P.M.

PRESENT: Messrs. Boudin, Delowitz, Frumkin, Halpern, Levine and Lvovitch.

The following matters were discussed and duly decided upon.

1) The request for remittance for the building in Buenos Aires. The cable from Mr. Taubenschlag and the letter from Mr. Surovich were read. After discussion an immediate remittance of \$10,000. on account of the \$15,000. allocation heretofore made was authorized.

2) The situation in England. Messrs. Lvovitch and Halpern presented a request that 500 £ be advanced for the expenses required for the reorganization of London Ort Society and for the establishing of a liaison office to cooperate with the U.N.R.A. and other relief organizations in London. The question was raised whether the monies on hand with Lord Rothschild could not be used for that purpose. It was pointed out that it was by no means certain that Lord Rothschild was in England as he had recently been working in the near East. The request was granted and a remittance of 500 £ to David Mowshevitch was authorized.

3) Planning Commission. Mr. Lvovitch presented the request for an allocation of \$1200. for the expenses of the Planning Commission headed by Professor Frankfurt. Mr. Levine opposed this request until a definite outline of the work to be

done be presented. It was finally decided, Mr. Levine not voting, that \$200.00 be advanced for the preliminary work and the balance when a proper outline of the work to be done would be presented.

4) Mr. Boudin brought up the request of the Council of Volunteer Organizations cooperating with U.N.R.A., headed by Professor Chamberlain, for a contribution toward the expenses of the Council. It was authorized that a contribution up to \$500. be approved.

5) Algiers. Mr. Lvovitch announced that Pierre Dreyfus was willing to undertake a trip to North Africa for the purpose of establishing work there. After discussion Mr. Lvovitch was authorized to enter into such arrangement at a salary not to exceed \$100. per week, plus expenses.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:15 P.M.
